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ACTIVITY SHEET: What do you think? Scenarios



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Read the following scenarios to your students and ask them to stand next to the sign they think best describes the behaviour: Bullying, cyberbullying, not bullying, or undecided.

Scenario	Answer
A student creates a fake email address for a new classmate and uses it to embarrass him by sending secret admirer emails to another classmate.	cyberbullying
2. Every lunchtime a student tells his friends to play in an area away from a new student to exclude him.	cyberbullying
3. A student uses a phone to take an embarrassing photo of a friend and sends the photo to everyone at school – even when this friend asked her not to send it.	bullying
4. A student has a friend who loves horses. Before she gets to school this friend decorates her desk with pictures of horses and writes 'Gina loves horses' on her pencil case. Gina is very embarrassed by the pictures when she arrives.	cyberbullying
5. A student constantly teases a younger student on the school bus every day encouraging others to join in the name calling.	not bullying
6. A student keeps sending anonymous nasty text messages to someone they don't like. That student, the recipient, is upset about receiving these messages and doesn't know who is sending them.	bullying
7. Someone posts a photo of a friend on their Facebook page without the friend's permission. The friend asks them to remove it, but they refuse.	not nice but not bullying
8. A student spreads unkind rumours regularly to their friends about a girl they don't like to deliberately hurt the feelings of the girl.	bullying
9. A new student starts at school and quickly becomes the most popular person at school. Someone creates a 'We hate them' webpage and regularly encourages their friends to post nasty messages on it.	cyberbullying
10. A student tells a friend a secret but forgets to tell him to not tell others. The friend then posts this secret on their Facebook page. The student is very embarrassed.	not nice but not bullying
